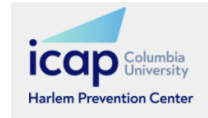


I Am Study

I Am is a study from the HIV Prevention Trials Network (www.hptn.org) that's looking at how PrEP and Gender Affirming services can help prevent HIV.

I Am is helping connect women of trans experience and anyone along the trans femme spectrum to PrEP and gender affirming hormone therapy, as desired. *I Am* has employed two black trans women as Peer Health Navigators, who help people get into the study and support them along the way.

If you:

- Identify as a transgender woman, woman of trans experience, or along the feminine spectrum
- Are at least 18 years of age & HIV negative
- Are willing to attend multiple study visits

You could be eligible for the *I Am Study*! This is a paid study opportunity.
